Our clubs are always very popular and often oversubscribed.

We put a limit on the size of clubs to accommodate adult/child ratio requirements relating to the age group. We pride ourselves on clubs being enriching and we think clubs have more of an impact when there is a small group of around 15 pupils. If the clubs become oversubscribed, we will ensure there is a fair allocation of places in the clubs on offer. We aim to give each child at least 2 clubs.

Paid Clubs

Where the schools employ a tutor or coach to deliver a club, there is a small fee. This goes directly to the coaches.

Please note, the dance clubs will only proceed when we have the 15 allocations and payments have been made in advance of the spring term. We have accounted for school closures/early finishes, so some clubs are £50 and some are £55.


Vantage Education will only run the clubs once the club has been filled with 15 pupils and all payments have been made.

Yoga and Movement – A calming and relaxing end to the day. Using stretching and movement to connect the body and mind.

Homework Club – A new addition to a club timetable and a request from some our parents. An opportunity to revisit and secure learning that has taken part in the classroom.

Latin Dance – Latin dancing is known for being a versatile and inspiring form of movement to Latin music.

Multisport – A trained coach will support children to develop their sports skills as well as their spatial awareness and team skills. Building up children's stem knowledge and overview.

Robotics Club - structured program that introduces children to the world of robotics through hands-on activities and collaborative projects.

Astronomy Club - The Astronomy After-School Club is a fun and interactive introduction to the wonders of space! Children will explore planets, stars, and the Moon through stories, hands-on activities, and simple experiments. They'll learn about the night sky, create their own constellations, and discover exciting facts about the universe in a way that's engaging and easy to understand.

Photography club - The Photography Club is a creative space where children can explore the world through a lens! They'll learn basic photography skills, experiment with capturing light, colors, and textures, and create their own mini photo projects. Through fun, hands-on activities, they'll discover how to tell stories with pictures and develop their artistic eye.

Hip Hop Dance - The Hip Hop Dance Club is an energetic and exciting way for children to express themselves through movement! They'll learn fun dance routines, basic hip-hop moves, and develop rhythm and coordination in a supportive environment. With upbeat music and lots of creativity, this club encourages confidence, teamwork, and a love for dance

Ballet - The Ballet Club introduces children to the grace and beauty of ballet in a fun and supportive environment. They'll learn basic positions, movements, and simple routines while developing coordination, balance, and confidence. Through music and creative expression, this club nurtures a love for dance and the arts.

Having fun with phonics club - a range of fun, engaging and mixed ability phonics games and activities that will build on the daily teaching of early reading

Arts and Crafts – getting creative juices flowing and doing all things crafty, from painting to box modelling from jewellery making to drawing

Contemporary Dance - Contemporary Club is all about **fun!** Children can come along to show off and practice their favourite moves and learn routines to popular music.

Puppet making - an opportunity to bring a puppet to life. Pupils will plan, design and make their own unique puppet. They will learn how to sew and join different materials. The group will then create their own puppet show building on their storytelling and creative skills.

Board Game Club – a place to learn strategic play, resilience, turn-taking, sustained concentration and the understanding the concept of winning and losing in a safe space – as well as having lots of fun. We will use large scale traditional board games.

Choir Club - a safe space for children to express themselves through performance and singing. Songs will develop children's understanding of tone, pitch, volume and beats. They will also learn how they can move their body freely to music.

STEM Club- an introduction to coding: children will develop their engineering and coding skills through play-based learning using resources such as Lego, marble runs and kinetic sand.

Painting Club - enable children to experience and experiment with a variety of different textures and techniques.

Street Dance - mixture of commercial street dance, hip-hop and general techniques that help enhance coordination and rhythm.
